SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR FOLEY: It's all in the transcript. It's all public. The press was there. I'm going to vote no on this amendment. I know people want to move on. I want to move on, too. We've got a lot of work yet to do this session. I'm going to vote no. I urge you to vote no. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Foley. Further discussion? There are no lights on. Senator Don Pederson, recognize you to close on your amendment, AM2855.

SENATOR D. PEDERSON: Thank you, Mr. President. I tried very deliberately not to say very much about what Mr. Foley had to say... Senator Foley had to say in the discussions we've had before. There was a transcript that was prepared that showed what exactly was said, and I'll read from what Senator Foley said: A great deal of the confusion, I think, that's being deliberately offered on the floor, I think some senators are deliberately trying to confuse us as to what this amendment is really about. They're trying to say, look, what Foley is really trying to do here, he's trying to assault the family planning program in Nebraska. That's nonsense. Well, is it nonsense? Is that...is what he was trying to do as deliberate now as what he's saying at this moment? I don't think so. I'm trying to avoid that. I'm trying to say let's don't muddy the water any more. Let's approach this intelligently. Let's approach this in such a way that the next Legislature will have a handle on what the issues are and how to approach them, not being a doctrinal matter but being a matter involving the health needs That's the primary concern. And I think to do anything different is obfuscating the issue and I think, frankly, that people voted on this thinking that they were simply putting additional funding for the welfare of women. It was not the subliminal concern that is now being expressed by Senator Foley, and which was expressed in the e-mail that he sent to his constituents. So with that, I would ask you to
