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SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I've only got...if I can hold out for seven hours, it will be 11:46. I believe I can hold out for seven hours, and I've got at least three amendments up there. I heard Senator Erdman, so he's listening. He's probably the only one who's listening. I gave you the time and the number. Seven plus three does not equal eleven, so I have to stand up here for eight hours, and I think I can do it. I think I can make it, for I've only just begun. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. Further discussion? Senator Louden.

SENATOR LOUDEN: Thank you, Mr. President and members of the body. As I...one good positive aspect of this discussion this afternoon to come out of this is that now there are two senators that have mentioned on the floor that innocent children and that are getting killed in Omaha. So I think that's one positive aspect of it, that if we can get that across, we only have 47 more senators to go to realize that, then probably perhaps something can be done on that. This Byrne fund, or whatever you're calling it nowadays, I have some questions about it. I think it probably works all right. I question how it's funding. My observation has always been that when the federal government puts money out for something like that, it's more or less an entitlement, and it's something that the federal government starts, and then it's up to the local citizens or local entities to pick up and go with if it works out quite well for them, whether it was WPA, or whatever it was. It's always been that way, and it probably always will be that way, that the federal government isn't necessarily going to fund everything all the time. Before we had the Byrne fund, I think we had WING, or whatever that was out there. And before that, the Safety Patrol had an undercover people out in western Nebraska. You can go back for 25 years or so, and they've been fighting drug enforcements, and perhaps even longer than 25 years, I don't remember. All I remember is, some of the patrolmen that were on the undercover I knew when they were kids. So anyway, with that, has went on for a long time, these various funds and various entitlements. This year, I introduced a bill, and I
