And that's how they show respect for the laws of this state. But I want to get all of that into the record. But let me tell you one of the underhanded things they do to you-all's children, and they like to do it on university campuses. They'll catch some of these users, and tell them, if you will make however many cases for us, we won't press these charges against you. In other words, be a snitch for us. So the person, feeling pressured, not wanting mommy and daddy to know that they've been bad children, will snitch, rat out three people. Then, when they want to stop, that's when the cops let them know what cops really are about. They say, oh, no, you can't stop. You're effective. Your classmates trust you. We want you to rat out some more. And if the person says, I'm not going to do it, then they say, all right, then we're going to process these charges, and when you're locked up, we're going to put out the word that you're a snitch, and we'll give the names of the ones that you ratted out, so that it's clear. Then the person has a double amount of pressure. And law enforcement officers in this state have done that. There was one female student, and a deal had been made with her, after she did a certain amount of snitching. And the cops and the prosecutors didn't want to deliver on the deal, and the Eighth Circuit wound up saying, you made this deal, you endangered these young people, and you're going to deliver on your end of it. She upheld hers. The cops are the ones who wanted to renege on the deal that they made. They're rotten, ratty people, and they lie. Whenever a cop's mouth is moving, in most cases, he or she is lying. And they're taught to lie at the academy. And they're told, if you lie, you stick with that lie, no matter what. If Jesus comes down with 1,000 angels, you say, well, Jesus must be mistaken, but what I said is the truth. Courts know they lie. They acknowledge in their opinions that cops lie. They are allowed to lie. And I'm going to give some specific references to a statute and to a provision of you-all's constitution which your law enforcement people work with the federal government to circumvent. They're undermining your...
