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these young people don't know how ratty these cops are, how disingenuous they are, how they lie, how they pick snitches and give them a break? And I'll go into a little more detail about how that snitching operation works. And the cops know it. You can ask some of the people around here who have been law enforcement officers and they'll tell you how they get these snitches, how somebody in narcotics gets a snitch who's committing other crimes, and the cop in the area where the other crimes are committed will get his snitches from the other side. And each one says, if you snitch for me, I won't bust you for what you've done. They got all kinds of ways of ensnaring people in a tawdry web of lying and snitching.
