Senator Adrian "Pederson." I forget the name of this movie, but this one guy is either chasing a mutt, or the mutt is chasing him. Then this guy opens his mouth and his tongue rolls out and it's about six inches long. That's what happens to politicians when they're running for their life to get an office that they think they won't win. Why, they take money from people who are very questionable in what they do, but all they want is that money. Senator Pederson...I meant Senator Adrian Smith doesn't talk about these things ordinarily. That's why every time he stands up he knows people are going to say he's posturing. Well, he knows I'm going to say it. But in the same way that one person addressing himself or herself can say we, using what's called the royal "we," I can make myself plural and say people, when maybe I should say a person. He's a grown man. His skin has got to be thick because he's a politician. Now, if he can't take the little bit of warmth that I'm going to direct his way, how in the world is he going to function on Capitol Hill where they will cut him off at the knees? He won't even know what has happened to him. He'll reach up to put his hat on, Senator Aguilar, and he'll say, my head, where's my head? And the lobbyist will say, here it is, on this platter; do you want it back? He'll say, yeah, I want it back. Well, why do you want your...why do you want your head back, Congressman Smith from Nebraska? Well, if I don't have my head back, I don't have anything to put my hat on; that's why I need my head. Don't that beat all? Senator Smith will take the place of...I meant, yeah, of Congressman Osborne, who has told the state...after he has blundered and fumbled and helped take money from a program, from what I heard. Somebody said the Nebraska delegation voted to cut this money. If that's true, then why is he going to vote to cut the money, then come here and say the state ought to do something about it and then maybe next year something will be made better? Does that makes sense? Only in Nebraska; only in Nebraska, where something other than fluoride is in the water. It's got to be in the water. There's too much of this insanity and inanity throughout this state. But I do believe that if people want to send Senator Smith to represent them in Congress,...
