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did last summer or this hearing. But I...you know, you might want to ask Senator Preister that question. Maybe his recollection would be different from mine. But I don't think that was a huge point.

SENATOR JANSSEN: All right. Thank you, Senator Schimek.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: You're welcome.

SENATOR JANSSEN: I don't believe it would be necessary to ask Senator Preister anything. Like I say, I've sat on several boards, and we've had closed sessions before. And I always felt as though we had given plenty of advance notice at that time. With that, thank you, Senator.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Janssen. Further discussion? Seeing no lights on, Senator Langemeier, you're recognized to close.

SENATOR LANGEMEIER: I'd waive closing.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Langemeier does not wish to close. The question before the body is, shall AM2742 be adopted to the committee amendments? All in favor vote aye; opposed, nay. We're voting on the adoption of the Langemeier amendment to the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs Committee amendment. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 30 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of the amendment to the committee amendments.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The Langemeier amendment has been adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Back to discussion of the committee amendments themselves, AM2116. There are no lights on. Senator Schimek waives closing. The question before the body is, shall the committee amendments to LB 898 be adopted? All in favor vote aye; opposed, nay. We're voting on adoption of AM2116, offered by the Government, Military and Veterans Affairs
