The question before the body is the Health and Human Services Committee amendments to LB 1107. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 34 ayes, 0 nays on the adoption of committee amendments.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The committee amendments have been adopted. Anything further on the bill, Mr. Clerk?
