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been developed injures school personnel or another student as a result of the misuse of necessary asthma or anaphylaxis medical supplies, the parent or guardian of the student for whom such plan has been developed will be responsible for any and all costs associated with injury. AM2606 also amends Section 25-21,280 to provide immunity from civil liability for any school nurse, nurse designee or other designated adult for any act or omission related to the self-management of a school's...or of a student's asthma or anaphylaxis condition under the bill that results in damage or injury, except when damage or injury was caused by a willful or wanton act of omission of a nurse, nurse designee, or designated adult. With that, that concludes the comments on the amendment. I would just ask for adoption of the committee amendment to LB 1148. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Jensen. You heard the opening on the Health and Human Services Committee amendment. There are...Mr. Clerk, please.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Cornett would move to amend the committee amendments with AM2933. (Legislative Journal pages 1260-1261.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Cornett, you're recognized to open on AM2933.

SENATOR CORNETT: Yes, AM2933 is a technical amendment to the committee amendment. In the committee amendment, it says that the asthma action plan would just be drawn up between the parents and the school district, and does not include the physician. The physician is the primary person in drawing up the action plan, and then it is agreed upon by the parent and the school. And the second part is on page 2, beginning with "licensed" in line 3 through "provider" in line 4, and insert "physician." This is just a technical amendment to the committee amendment, and I would appreciate your supporting in passing this amendment. Thank you.
