SENATOR KREMER: What do you mean that it would become an issue?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, Senator Schimek said that you had suggested that if this provision allowing for the checkoff to be extended became an issue for the bill, this provision would be allowed to go away. I'm paraphrasing.

SENATOR KREMER: Okay, I did...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Why did you think it might become such an issue?

SENATOR KREMER: I don't know that I thought it would become an issue, because I thought, we've spent money to put this on the income tax forms, and we'd have to spend money to take it back off, it's all voluntary, anybody that would like to contribute that dollar could, so I did not think it would probably be an issue.
