SENATOR CUDABACK: They would probably vote to...

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Kill her bill?

SENATOR CUDABACK: That's up to them.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: You're a mean man, Senator Cudaback, but my time is up. But my light is on. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR BAKER: Time. Thank you, Senator Chambers, anyway. Senator Janssen, you're recognized to speak on FA641.

SENATOR JANSSEN: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the Legislature. I remember when we put the checkoff on the ballot. Yeah, I just don't...I didn't really think it was the right thing to do, but, you know, if someone wants to use that opportunity to support the State Fair, that's up to their discretion. They don't have to do it. You know, it's something you're not...that's not imposed on you to do. And it's my understanding that it has probably cost fifty-some thousand dollars to get this program initiated, and it brings in something, the last couple of years, something around sixty-some thousand dollars. So you know, it's about to the break-even point. So I see nothing wrong with leaving this on. I did not support it at the time. I thought it was foolishness. But seeing what it...it amazed me that it would generate that much revenue. So apparently there are a lot of people in this state that feel as though the State Fair needs to be there and it needs to exist. If any of you have been out there recently, you can see what this has done. I mean, they're starting to rejuvenate the State Fair again. And if we're going to have a fair, then let's support it. And apparently, there are enough people in this state that want to use the checkoff to go ahead and be...contribute to that...to the State Fair by this means. Nobody is holding their feet to the hot fire. It's entirely up to them. So if this is going to help rejuvenate the State Fair, I see nothing wrong with it. To my knowledge, I did not use the checkoff, so that...maybe someone else in here...I bet Senator Cudaback did. I bet his...you know, his income tax form is
