I'm going to offer amendments to this section that we're looking at now, because there is another way besides the one Senator Erdman offered. I can simply move to reinstate the original language, and strike the new matter. So there are multiple ways for us to deal with a difficult issue, and I'm prepared to deal with this one. Senator Cudaback may love the State Fair, but his State Fair is going to get \$2 million. And maybe some of those old-time cars, the owners of them who will be benefited by his bill, may someday want to have a display at the State Fair. And while they're enjoying what they can do thanks to Senator Cudaback's bill, which I left alone, and they have all of these palatial surroundings in the State Fair thanks to the \$2 million every year that they get,...

SENATOR BAKER: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...they can think back to this day, March 28, when they killed a colleague's bill. And I'm going to help him do that, and he won't live it down the rest of the session.
