CLERK: 8 ayes, 11 nays, Mr. President, on that component of the
committee amendments.

SENATOR BAKER: The amendment is not adopted. Okay. The other
divided question, the first division, is Sections 1, 3, and 4.
Senator Kremer, would you care to open on that, please. (FA643,
Legislative Journal pages 1262-1264.)

SENATOR KREMER: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the body.
The balance now is everything but the extension of the checkoff,
which provides for the review of the leases. And I stated in
the committee amendments the different aspects of that. The
\$150,000 threshold is any maintenance that...or new construction
over \$150,000 has to go through the review process and then
submitted to the DAS, the Governor, the Legislature, for their
approval. With that, I ask your support of the committee
amendments that remain.

SENATOR BAKER: Thank you, Senator Kremer. Senator Louden,
you're recognized to speak.

SENATOR LOUDEN: Thank you, Mr. President and members. I'd like
to ask Senator Schimek some questions, if she would yield,
