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to try to find an answer for you. I don't believe so, Senator.

SENATOR LOUDEN: Okay. Would Senator Wehrbein have the answer to that?

SENATOR BAKER: Senator Wehrbein? Don't see Senator Wehrbein on the floor, Senator Louden. I don't see him.

SENATOR LOUDEN: Okay. Perhaps Senator Kremer. I would like to know, because it's my understanding that there has been buildings built by organizations there, and also by Lancaster County. And my question is, is who has control over those buildings? Do those entities get to use those buildings when they build them there? Or are they then completely under the control of the Fair Board? And how does it work with this horse racing that goes on there? Who has control over those buildings on the horse racing and how this all works? Because whether we allow people to construct more businesses on that fairgrounds, if that's the case, then perhaps some of it should just be sold, and the money used to either support the State Fair or something else. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR BAKER: Thank you, Senator Louden. There are no further lights on. Senator Kremer, you're recognized to close on the first division of the divided question.

SENATOR KREMER: I'd waive closing.

SENATOR BAKER: Senator Kremer waives. The question is, shall AM643 be adopted to the bill? All those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote nay. Has everyone voted who cares to vote? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on this component of the committee amendments.

SENATOR BAKER: The amendment is adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill, Mr. President.
