SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Landis, would you yield to a question from Senator Chambers?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Senator Landis, I had had discussions with people before about what would happen with this bill, and I've been not as attentive as I needed to be. You had an amendment, which I think had worked...had been worked out with some of the principals, and if I understand it correctly, so that I will be where I would like to be, the amendment that you offered has been adopted?

SENATOR LANDIS: No, it's about to be; it's under consideration now, and it allows Omaha to continue to spend the sales tax on libraries and other things for the pendency of the bonds that they now have issued.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, what became of your amendment that was being considered, because my amendment is now up?

SENATOR LANDIS: Oh, I'm sorry. It was adopted, excuse me. Your amendment is up because the amendment rather quickly was adopted a moment ago, and it will become effective at the point at which AM2576 is adopted to the bill.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: And the amendment of yours which was adopted replaced one that you had pending prior?

SENATOR LANDIS: That's right.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. Mr. President, members of the Legislature, Senator Cudaback, my dear friend, Senator Cudaback. I'm so happy to see you back in the chair functioning as you always do. And because Senator Cudaback is in the chair, and it would take perhaps all of the afternoon to deal with these amendments, I am dedicating to Senator Cudaback the withdrawal at this point of every amendment that I have pending, and for the record I will number them: FA580, FA581, FA582, FA583, FA584, FA585, FA586, FA587, FA588, FA589, FA590. And I want Senator Cudaback to know that nobody has scored that kind of victory on me in such a short time, since I've been in this
