This doesn't involve any redistribution. redistribute funds. We're simply adding money. The second thing is the way we're adding money. We're taking...I think as Senator correctly pointed out, this is not money that was directed at one point to the Highway Trust and went out, and so on and so This is money that has never been directed to the Highway Trust Fund that is now going that direction in the Highway Allocation Fund. I think it's easy to lose sight of the fact that, what if we would come on a situation where we could lower the sales tax rate? Then what happens? Do we...are we obligated, then, to replace the money, this half cent that's lost to the Highway Allocation Fund, when that happens? don't think we should put ourselves in that sort of a spot, and that's exactly what we're doing with this proposal. So for that reason I don't think it's a sound proposal, either from the standpoint that we're not making the hard decisions about redistribution, which I think we need to make, and we're not making a sustainable decision, in terms of appropriating money to the Highway Trust Fund. Thank you.
