March 28, 2006 LB 1226

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Beutler. Are you finished, Senator Beutler? There are no further lights on. Senator Langemeier, you're recognized to close on AM2633.

SENATOR LANGEMEIER: Thank you, Mr. President, and I thank everyone for their discussion on this amendment. I am going to let it go to a vote, but I do want to kind of precondition this vote with the idea that--and Senator Beutler and I have talked about this--that the section in here involving the grant funding for the NRD, which I believe they do need that funding, will be subject to being cut if we do this. Senator Schrock has offered an amendment on the A bill to cut the funding, both for the NRD funding, as well as the storm water, in half. I would advise you of that, and I would ask that you consider that in your vote for the striking of the storm water, knowing that if we do strike this, the NRD portion could be stricken, and if we don't strike this, that we wouldn't strike the NRD funding, either, and address Senator Schrock's half the money amendment to LB 1226A. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Langemeier. You've heard the closing on AM2633. The question before the body is if that amendment should be adopted to the committee amendments to LB 1226. All in favor vote aye; opposed, nay. Voting on adoption of the Langemeier amendment, AM2633, which amends the committee amendments. Have you all voted on the Langemeier amendment who care to? Have you all voted who care to? Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 10 ayes, 16 nays, Mr. President, on the amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The amendment is not adopted.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Langemeier would move to amend with AM2632.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Langemeier, to open on AM2632.

SENATOR LANGEMEIER: I would ask that AM2632 be withdrawn, as well as AM2648.
