SENATOR SCHIMEK: That might be acceptable, Senator. I'd want to think about that a little bit.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I understand. So I'm just giving it to you because on Select File it's something that I may try to do.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Okay, thank you.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. Now on these new political parties...

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Yes.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...can there be a religious designation in the name of a party? Since you're talking about what cannot be used...

SENATOR SCHIMEK: I assume so.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Any name that's not used...that's not prohibited can be used?

SENATOR SCHIMEK: I would assume so.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: An obscenity could be used to name a party, couldn't it? Seriously.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: (Laugh) I know you're serious and I don't know the answer to your question but I would think not.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Well, since you're specifying which...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...names or words cannot be used, anything other than those can be used. And in a political setting, the right to free speech is viewed differently from the way it is in other contexts, on occasion.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: And let me think about that, Senator. Let me
