SENATOR ERDMAN: I understand that.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: So I...but if there should be further consideration of that, I'm not opposed to that, Senator Erdman. I just don't envision it.

SENATOR CUDABACK: I did, Senator. (Visitors introduced.) On with discussion, Senator Erdman.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Smith.
