SENATOR CUDABACK: It is withdrawn. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Senator, are you referring to your request for a division? Is that...

SENATOR SMITH: Yes, that is correct.

CLERK: ...what you want to do? Okay.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Smith, would you inform the body of what you are doing? I think we can do it from the floor.

SENATOR SMITH: Thank you, Mr. President. I am requesting a division that would be Section 5, which was the original green copy and then the remainder of the committee amendments that include the four bills as mentioned in the committee statement.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Mr. Clerk, have you got that? It is divisible as the body knows. Senator Schimek, which division would you like to take up first? It's your choice.

SENATOR SCHIMEK: I'd like to take up the division regarding Section 5, please.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Section 5. Senator Schimek, you will be recognized to open on Section 5. (FA648, Legislative Journal page 1305.)

SENATOR SCHIMEK: Thank you, Mr. President. I truly hope that we don't need to...I hope that we don't repeat all the arguments that we've already made this morning. I think there's been good discussion. I think some people like Senator Chambers may still want to enter with some comments that he hasn't made before, but I'm not going to stand up and repeat the arguments that I've made. I just hope that you will vote for this division of the question. I think it's good public policy. And I'm certainly willing to listen to any changes that you think we should make in language, but I think basically the policy is good. Thank you.
