SENATOR CUDABACK: The house is under call. All unauthorized personnel please leave the floor. Unexcused senators report to the Chamber. The house is under call. Senator Heidemann. And he will accept call-in votes, when you get time, Mr. Clerk, or when you're available. Senator Heidemann is excused. Senator Johnson, check in, please.
