Who do you believe in, the dead man? Or you believe in the zombie who got up from the dead and walked, and after he was walking, told you hypocrites how you're supposed to live? You know why I call you hypocrites? Not according to my standards. You're all right with me. You're just a bunch of sin-cursed people who have lost your way. You know right from wrong, but you choose to do wrong. That's the nature of people. I'm judging you by the standards you set, and every time you bring that preacher up here every morning, he reinforces it. And when you have some of your colleagues who are senators who get up there and pray, same thing. You set the standard. I'm judging you by the standard you set.

SENATOR BAKER: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: So now if you're not going to live by your standard, why do you condemn me for calling you a hypocrite? Your conduct is what condemns you, and you know it. Here we're talking about a pittance. You probably go to church and hear your preacher or your priest talk about the poor. They even have what they call poor boxes in some churches. People put money in it. And if you all go there, you probably go there and empty out the poor box and put it in your pocket and run home with it. That's how much principle or lack of principle you got. That's why I say on your religion, bah humbug. It's nothing. It's below, beneath contempt. You know why? Because of the way you all dishonor it. You're in a position to do something now, a small thing, and you won't even do the little thing. Thank you, Mr. President.
