SENATOR CUNNINGHAM: Thank you, Senator Baker and members. I am going to pull this amendment because, as Senator Beutler told you, it does goof things up. But...so we will pull that, but I do want to make one thing clear for the record. Senator Chambers, you made the statement that I work for the Grocers' Association. I absolutely do not work for the Grocers' Association. I'm the director of Hometown Merchants, which is a multi-industry association. So I just want that clear on the record. I used to be a barber, not like Delilah, who cut people's hair and they lose their strength; take all their secrets and betray them. People felt better when they got out of my chair; they looked better too. But you know what happened, Senator Louden? sometimes a person would bring me a Pierce-Arrow head and want a Cadillac haircut, and I'd tell them, no, I can only work with what you bring me. But I'm going to stay on this that I'm talking about, because I enjoy it in the same way you all enjoy your religion. You all go to church every Sunday, some of you, and you pray. And I'm going to put that question to you again. What do you have in your mind when you pray? Why do you go to church? What are you afraid of? You're scared of something. You don't go there because it teaches you how to do the right thing, to help the less fortunate.
