Reserve as an endowment expires by the terms of the amendment June 30, 2007. Beginning on July 1, 2007, the amendment provides that the endowment fund will consist of any funds made available as a result of the constitutional amendment proposed in LB 1006, to follow. The amendment also provides that if no funds are placed in the endowment after July 1, 2007, then the private endowment provider may terminate the agreement with us. To summarize, if the constitutional amendment passes, then the funds set aside as a result thereof would become the endowment. If the constitutional amendment does not pass, then the next Legislature would need to decide if an alternative means of funding is available, or the Legislature could elect to terminate the program. The amendment also makes clarifying changes to the means by which the regulations governing the program are adopted in order to ensure harmony among the related regulations for existing early childhood education programs. I ask for your consideration and adoption of the amendment. Thank you.

And the answer, of course, is yes. We have at-risk children, and that's the ones that are going to be treated by this. So the question is, how do we go about funding this?
