March 29, 2006 LB 1006, 1256

SPEAKER BRASHEAR: Thank you, Mr. President. Members of the body, I appreciate very much the full and fair debate, the careful consideration. I think we've heard it all for this round. I would appreciate the advancement of the bill. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Brashear. Question before the body is, shall LB 1256 advance to E & R Initial? All in favor vote aye; opposed vote nay. The question before the body is advancement of LB 1256, offered by Senator Brashear. Have you all voted on the question who care to? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 35 ayes, 1 nay, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 1256.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 1256 does advance. Mr. Clerk, we now go to...did you have any items, Mr. Clerk, for the record?

CLERK: No, sir, I do not. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you. We now go to LB 1006. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: LB 1006, introduced by Senator Bourne at the request of the Governor. (Read title.) Bill was introduced on January 10, referred to the Education Committee, advanced to General File. I do have committee amendments, Mr. President. (AM2815, Legislative Journal page 1233.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. Senator Bourne, to open on LB 1006.

SENATOR BOURNE: Thank you, Mr. President, members. This is the funding mechanism that was discussed on the previous bill. I'm not going to explain what's in the underlying bill, because it has changed significantly. I do want to point out, however, if you look at the one-liner, it says Bourne, Baker, Combs, Cudaback, et al., at the request of the Governor, and I will tell you that, to my knowledge, I'm not certain if it's still at
