across the state, representation from across the state, this is very draconian in terms of attendance requirements. And then on page 4 it talks about the Commissioner of Labor appointing the state elevator inspector, and then experience in installation, maintenance and repair of elevators, certified as a qualified elevator inspector by an association accredited by the American Society of Mechanical Engineers, or have not less than five years' journeyman experience in elevator installation, maintenance, and so forth. But my concern is, and I'm...this is the last time I'm going to speak, my concern is that this is a burden on small business with expensive requirements, not to mention reduced access in rural areas that will result because of this extra burden. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Smith. Senator Baker. Senator Smith, did you yield your time to somebody? Okay. Senator Baker. The question has been called. Do I see five hands? I do see five hands. The question before the body is, shall debate cease on AM2934, the Beutler amendment? All in favor vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. We've voting on ceasing debate on the Beutler amendment, AM2934. Record please, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 27 ayes, 0 nays to cease debate, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was successful. Debate does cease. Senator Beutler, you're recognized to close.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Once again, this is a relative minor amendment that adds one piece of information that should be supplied by the applicant, and that information has to do with the description of any and all accidents that are...that have caused personal injury or property damage involving conveyances installed, inspected, maintained, or serviced by the applicant. So just getting a little additional, hopefully, relevant information from the applicant. Thank you.
