SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Cunningham.

SENATOR CUNNINGHAM: Yes.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Senator Cunningham, were you going to

withdraw this?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: I mean we have a problem with the green copy and I don't think any of us want to support the original green copy, probably including Senator Synowiecki.

SENATOR CUNNINGHAM: Oh, are you talking about the fees on the elevators?

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Yes. I don't know where Senator Synowiecki is on that, but this is drafted...you didn't strike; you just added, right?

SENATOR CUNNINGHAM: Yes, this is added.

SENATOR WEHRBEIN: Well, we're adding to the original...

SENATOR CUNNINGHAM: Well, by statute, Senator Wehrbein, we have to...we have to provide the department there, they need to be able to charge what it takes for elevator inspection, so we have to do that. You know, if you believe that the fees are too high or something like that, that could be discussed. But it's just a matter of they only come in and do this every so many years, so it was from 1991 or 1992 when it last was statutorily changed.
