CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Erdman would offer FA667.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Erdman, to open on FA667.

SENATOR ERDMAN: Thank you, Mr. President. Again, the amendment before you would strike the word "shall" in Senator Thompson's previous amendment, AM3034, on line 22 of Section 3, which was page 2 of that amendment. And it would replace the word "shall" with "may" and again, it would simply allow the department discretion in the event that there are approved materials. They would not have to be distributed by the department but they may be distributed. Again, I believe Senator Thompson is in agreement and I would appreciate your support for the amendment. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Erdman. You've heard the opening on FA667. Open for discussion. No lights on. Senator Erdman waives closing. The question before the body is, shall FA667 be adopted? All in favor vote aye; opposed, nay. The question before the body is the Erdman amendment, FA667, to LB 994. Please record, Mr. Clerk.
