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SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute. Are you through? Thank you, Senator Beutler. Sorry I warned you when you were completed. On with discussion. Senator Brown.

SENATOR BROWN: Thank you, Mr. President, members. I wonder if Senator Schrock would yield to a couple questions.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Schrock, would you yield?

SENATOR SCHROCK: Yes.

SENATOR BROWN: Senator Schrock, in your remarks earlier, you said that we have taken money during the good times as well as the bad. Can you detail when we have taken money from the Environmental Trust, and what it went for?

SENATOR SCHROCK: Well, you know, when we came down here this year, we heard about all the revenue that we had, and we're going to have big tax cuts, and we can make a lot of things whole that we cut the past years. And Senator Pederson isn't here, but Senator Johnson can maybe help me out. Didn't we take about \$2 million out of the Environmental Trust for the cleanup site at the Mead that the university needed to clean up? And I think that came at the recommendation of the Governor. And that causes some of us some pain, when we're telling the Environmental Trust Board where to spend their money, when they have a grant process...

SENATOR BROWN: Okay, thank you. But is that the only amount of money that we've taken from the...

SENATOR SCHROCK: I think that's the only thing that's taken this year. And I'm looking at Senator Beutler, if he can think of something else.

SENATOR BROWN: What about in the past?

SENATOR SCHROCK: We've used it to fund water issues, LB 962. But one of those issues we did go through the grant process, and so,...
