SENATOR BAKER:    Time.

SENATOR CHAMBERS:    Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR BAKER:    Thank you, Senator Chambers.    Senator Beutler.

SENATOR BEUTLER:    Thank you, Senator Baker.    Senator Jensen, in answer to your previous question, I want to go forward with the bill.    I think we need to do something.    I really do appreciate all the work you and the committee have put into this, but it's such an important subject that I think it's worth talking about, even for some considerable period of time.    And, you know, I'm kind of curious where you think all this goes long term.    I mean, without health insurance coverage, what is the end to all this, Senator?

SENATOR JENSEN:    You know, the...

SENATOR BEUTLER:    Tell me what your personal vision is about...

SENATOR JENSEN:    Okay.

SENATOR BAKER:    Senator Jensen,...

SENATOR BEUTLER:    ...about how...

SENATOR BAKER:    ...would you respond?

SENATOR BEUTLER:    ...we take care of healthcare coverage in America.

SENATOR JENSEN:    Yes, and thank you.    There are a lot of things that enter into this.    We have employers in this state and...which will provide insurance for the employee, but don't make it optional for the spouse or for the children.    I think we need to work on that.    As responsible employers, they should provide coverage for the spouse, for the children.    We also have then employees who can, through their employment, get insurance for the children, but that's more expensive, and if they can get them on Medicaid, they will do that.    I don't believe that is a proper assessment.    There are...
