SENATOR BAKER: Time. I'm sorry. One minute.

SENATOR JENSEN: And so if we can provide services outside of that, and I'll absolutely go along with what Senator Byars was saying, is that it's a total picture of healthcare. Sure, we're dealing with Medicaid here, but it's a total picture that we're trying to address. I think this is part of that. I'm sorry. It's your time.

SENATOR BEUTLER: That's fine, Senator. Thank you. I appreciate that. And I did want to point out that there is balancing language in what you put in the bill. With respect to the department establishing a variety of limitations, you did indicate that in establishing, prioritizing and limiting coverages the department shall consider the effect of such coverage and limitations on recipients, the experience and outcomes of other states, the nature and scope of benchmark or benchmark-equivalent health insurance and other relevant factors.

SENATOR BAKER: Time. Thank you, Senator Beutler. Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Is this my third time, Mr. President?

SENATOR BAKER: Yes, it is, Senator.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. Senator Jensen, when Patrick Henry had made his statement, "Give me liberty or give me death," and he was a slaveholder, he said words to the effect, I will pay my devoir to virtue, or my acknowledgement to virtue, that I think slavery is wrong, it hurts those who are enslaved and those who do the enslaving, but I'm carried along by the attitude in the community; I'm a slaveholder; I'm going to stay a slaveholder. Well, I'm going to pay my devoir to Senator Jensen and all these people who studied this and came up with this amendment. Y'all did a great job. If there was such a thing as somebody going to heaven without dying, all of you would go. But I want to get down to the reality, because I deal often with people who are sick and have no way to get healthcare, so it's more than an academic exercise for me or
