The Nebraska Realtors Association, through Justin Brady, has contacted my office relative to their concerns with certain provisions of the original bill; however, they voice no objection to this specific provision. I would appreciate the advancement of AM2929 on to the underlying bill, LB 924. Thank you, Senator Cudaback.
