recall, the second Judiciary Committee priority bill was LB 1113. And within that bill was LB 1257 as introduced by Senator Brashear and that bill dealt with the Community Corrections Council. There's a minor fiscal note associated with that bill of roughly \$58,000 and that is the purpose of this A bill.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Bourne. Open for discussion on LB 1113A. Senator Bourne, there are no lights on. Senator Bourne waives closing. The question before the body is, shall LB 1113A advance? All in favor vote aye; opposed, nay. The question is, shall LB 1113A advance to E & R Initial? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

ASSISTANT CLERK: 29 ayes, 0 nays on the motion to advance, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 1113A does advance. We now go to LB 1222A. Mr. Clerk, please.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, LB 1222A, introduced by Senator Baker. (Read title.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Baker, to open.

SENATOR BAKER: Thank you, President Cudaback and members. Me, too. This bill allows appropriation to the Public Service Commission the ability to disburse for cost reimbursement of the Enhanced Wireless 911 Fund, the provisions that are in LB 1222. And I would ask for its adoption or advancement to Select File. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Baker. Open for discussion. The motion by Senator Baker...Senator Baker, there are no lights on. He waives closing. The question before the body is, shall LB 1222A advance to E & R Initial? All in favor vote aye; opposed, nay. Voting on advancement of LB 1222A. Please record, Mr. Clerk.
