SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 1222A does advance. (Doctor of the day introduced.) We now go to Final Reading, E & R Final, motions to return to Select File for a specific amendment. Mr. Clerk, LB 994A.

ASSISTANT CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Thompson would move to return the bill to Select File for a specific amendment. The specific amendment is AM3057. (Legislative Journal page 1397.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Thompson, you're recognized to open on your motion to return.

SENATOR THOMPSON: Thank you, Mr. President. The motion to return is for an amendment which attaches the funding for the shaken baby education program and sudden infant death program that we amended into the budget yesterday.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Is that...

SENATOR THOMPSON: And it's, it will be for \$45,000 in the first year, \$31,000 in the second year, and then there are also two technical adjustments in that amendment that were recommended by the Fiscal Office.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Thompson. You've heard the opening on the motion to return. Discussion? There are no lights on...I'm sorry, Senator Erdman's light is on.

SENATOR ERDMAN: (Microphone malfunction)...Erdman. Thank you, Mr. President. I wonder if Senator Thompson would yield to a question.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Thompson, would you yield?

SENATOR THOMPSON: Yes.

SENATOR ERDMAN: Senator Thompson, again, just refresh my memory. Specifically, what is the money for in regards to the program?
