SENATOR CORNETT: I was going to say, I've got a stack over there, like two feet high.

So tell me exactly...so what your amendment is saying, and it's an amendment to LB 1024, is that the Class III school district, that's Bellevue, can reach out into the extraterritorial jurisdiction of the city, so this would resolve that issue that you presented to the Education Committee that day.

SENATOR CORNETT: Yes, and it's not just into the extraterritorial jurisdiction of the city. The city has been growing, has been annexing into the area that is in the Papillion School District but is clearly within the city boundaries of...or the jurisdiction of the city of Bellevue. We have two schools that sit in the middle of the city...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CORNETT: ...that are Papillion School District.

SENATOR BOURNE: Okay, I need to go back and look at the committee statement for that bill.

SENATOR CORNETT: Um-hum.

SENATOR BOURNE: I remember...I don't remember all the particulars, but I just wanted to make sure that that was the issue that you were discussing. I remember we had an excellent hearing on that that day. Thank you.
