SENATOR BAKER: Thank you, Senator Smith and Senator Friend. Senator Mines. Senator Mines calls the question. Do I see five hands? I do. The question at hand is whether...shall debate cease? All those in favor vote aye; those opposed vote nay. We are voting on ceasing debate. The message on the board is incorrect. We're voting on ceasing debate. Senator Mines?

SENATOR MINES: Mr. President, I'd like to call the house, please.

SENATOR BAKER: Senator Mines has requested a call of the house. Those in favor please vote aye; those opposed...I'm sorry. I'm going to direct the Clerk to clear the board so that we can get the correct message on the board. Mr. Clerk, please clear the board. The question is, shall the house go under call? All those...yes, Senator Bourne.

SENATOR BOURNE: Okay, we've had... has the question been called and we had five...do we have the votes for that?

SENATOR BAKER: No, we...

SENATOR BOURNE: I'm trying to find out exactly where we are at here.

SENATOR BAKER: We have had a call of the house to...in order to vote on the call the question. That's where we are.

SENATOR BOURNE: So...

SENATOR BAKER: We did not have the votes to cease debate.

SENATOR BOURNE: Okay, and so Senator Mines has moved for a call of the house, to get the votes to cease debate; is that where we're at?

SENATOR BAKER: That is correct, Senator Bourne.

SENATOR BOURNE: So the motion we're voting on now is a call of the house.
