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license regardless of what you do. If you continue to drink and you continue to consume alcohol, you're going to lose your license for 15 years. But if the...on the other side of the equation,...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR SYNOWIECKI: ...if you enroll in treatment, if you start to attend three, four AA meetings a week, if you undertake prevention and education activities, if you do all those things, guess what happens--you lose your license for 15 years. You need to be aware of what we're doing, and probation officers and treatment providers such as Senator Pedersen are going to lose a tool, and that tool is this incentive of this 15-year license suspension. Much like the sex offenders, where they go underground, we're going to have a large population of individuals that will lose that license for 15 years, and guess what? Chances are they'll drive anyway. And guess what? They'll drive, perhaps, drunk. And guess what? They'll drive without liability insurance. And guess what? They'll drive and they'll cause damage to our society. At least with this motivating factor here of that 15...of giving the court just a discretion, by giving the court discretion on...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time, Senator Synowiecki.

SENATOR SYNOWIECKI: ...third offense, we can capture lives and change and provide profound changes for people's lives that are...

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time, Senator.

SENATOR SYNOWIECKI: ...wrapped up in alcohol. Thank you, Senator Cudaback.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Synowiecki. (Visitors introduced.) On with discussion, the advancement. Senator Landis.
