roads that we've taken. And I'd just add, in closing, that we did whittle this back. We...Senator Bourne did come to me and he said, Mike, you know, we're not flexing political muscle here. And I said, Pat, I agree. And I think we made a lot of appropriate changes. So with that, I appreciate the discussion, I appreciate the concerns. If there are specific concerns in regard to the letter, for example, that create holes, or in regard to Senator Synowiecki's comments, that create flat-out inadequacies, Senator Pedersen's comments, if there's anything that creates those inadequacies, or something that just makes our criminal code less effective, I'd like to try to work through those issues. But I like the bill the way it is, and...but I'm open, and trying to be honest about that. I guess I would ask right now...I would finish up by asking for the advancement of LB 925. And I appreciate the discussion. Thank you.
