SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: ...than the legislators. Why do you think Senator Smith, who's running as hard as he can for Congress, would vote to override? It's not because he's examined anything carefully. He hasn't got time to examine anything carefully around here. We know it. He knows it. The Governor gave him permission and that's why he did it. SENATOR CUDABACK: Time, Senator Chambers.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Kruse, followed by Senator Chambers.

SENATOR KRUSE: Thank you, Mr. President, and greetings to all members. First, I cannot resist the opportunity to stand in joy in front of all of our colleagues that my seatmate and I are going to join together in voting green. Savor the moment. (Laughter) I could go on in the same spirit and say that Senator Chambers is the one who brought the two of us together but I won't get into that. (Laughter) To be very serious and responding on behalf of both of us here, this is authentic for each of us, I know. But also responding for the committee, we took our job very, very seriously. I don't think anybody doubts that but I want to affirm it what others have said. This was a thing that we considered in two different meetings. We looked it all over. We looked at all of the possibilities that there were for vetoes that were not taken as well as what happened to those that were. And as we looked it over, this is the place where we could really multiply our dollars and it is our responsibility to respond to that. It's not a criticism of anybody else, it's our response. Several reasons have been given for that and I'll not repeat them. I'll add one more.
