Community educational facilities are defined as facilities for education, early childhood development, or related programs for residents of the adjacent community area. Under the amendment, during the first five years 12.5 percent of all state sales tax within the district...

SENATOR CUDABACK: One minute.

SPEAKER BRASHEAR: ...and 25 percent of all local sales tax within the district would be devoted to the community partnership fund to subsidize financing of facilities developed in conjunction with the community partner under the community partnership plan. Sixty-two percent of all...62.5 percent all sales tax within the district, and 75 percent of all local sales tax within the district would be devoted to financing assistance for the entertainment and tourism development project. That would be in the first five years. I'll be out of time and I'll further explain what happens in the 6th through the 30th year on further time. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Brashear. Further discussion on AM3125 to the Revenue Committee amendments to LB 500? Senator Redfield.

SENATOR REDFIELD: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the body. If I could have a conversation with Senator Landis. Is he still here on the floor? Oh, he's bowing down before Senator Flood. Senator Landis...
