that we can put an amendment to, to take care of another problem. This is a minimum maintenance road; there isn't a lot of traffic, but still, there is a need to get across the railroad tracks. We are working with the railroads to come up with a solution, and that is where the situation lies at the moment. So again, I would thank everyone for putting in their opinions, and I would withdraw the amendment. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: It is withdrawn. Anything further on the bill? Senator Flood, motion please.

SENATOR FLOOD: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 79 to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You've heard the motion to advance LB 79 to E & R for engrossing. All in favor say aye. Opposed, nay. The ayes have it. It is advanced. We now go to General File. Mr. Clerk, special order, LB 529.

CLERK: LB 529, a bill by Senator Beutler. (Read title.) The bill was introduced in January of last year, at that time referred to the Judiciary Committee. The bill was advanced to General File. It was discussed briefly this year, Mr. President, on January 26. At that time the committee amendments were presented, as was an amendment to the committee amendments by Senator Beutler, AM1795. Senator, I had a note that you wanted to withdraw AM1795. I don't know if you want to do that now, or...

SENATOR BEUTLER: Mr. Clerk, I would do that now, and ask unanimous consent to substitute AM2787 for AM1795.

SENATOR CUDABACK: So ordered.

CLERK: The number again, Senator? I'm sorry. AM2787?

SENATOR BEUTLER: AM2787.
