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which we have now every place else in the state, I think, and we're all operating, and the courts are getting management information that's uniform from every place but Douglas County. That never changed because the court could never get them to change. They don't have that ultimate authority, and so we've limped along with our most populated county not giving the courts management information that is badly needed, because they don't...they won't adopt the same JUSTICE system of information management. All of this leads to inefficiencies.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Time, Senator Beutler. Thank you, Senator Beutler and Senator Thompson. Further discussion? Senator Hudkins, followed by Senator Landis.

SENATOR HUDKINS: Thank you, Mr. President and members of the body. I would like to ask Senator Beutler a few questions, if I may.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Beutler, would you yield?

SENATOR HUDKINS: Senator Beutler, the handout that has the transfer costs for clerk of the district court and so forth, do you have that handy?
