about the total salary and benefits over total revenue; do you have that, as well?

SENATOR BEUTLER: Yes.

SENATOR HUDKINS: All right. My question happens to deal with Lancaster, because that's what I'm most familiar with, and Lancaster County, the clerk of the district court would transfer in year 2013 at an estimated net cost per year of \$895,645. But if you look at the total salary and benefits over total revenue for Lancaster County, the fees that are brought in are \$519,000 and change, the salaries and benefits total \$1.1 million, for a difference of \$601,000. Well, the \$601,000 is the cost now, and under your proposal, the cost would be \$895,000. Can you tell me why there is an increase?

SENATOR BEUTLER: There are differences, Senator, for two reasons. First of all, one is on a fiscal year basis, and the other is on a calendar year basis, and secondly, the information is coming from slightly different sources, so there may be some differences there.

SENATOR HUDKINS: All right. When the state took over the assessment duties of nine counties, Saunders County was one of the first ones, I believe, that did take advantage of this. And now I have been told that it ended up costing the county more, and I'll give you my time. It ended up costing Saunders County more after this happened. So take the rest of my time and explain why this happened, and use the rest of the time as you see fit.

SENATOR BEUTLER: Senator Hudkins, thank you. Looking at the figures on the two charts that you pointed out, the one that shows Lancaster County at \$895,000, if you look at Lancaster County on the other chart, you see it at \$601,000, but below that you see the juvenile at \$294,000. So if you add \$294,000 to \$601,000, you're at \$894,000, so they're very, very close--\$894,000 versus \$895,000. And I'm sorry I can't be helpful on Saunders County, because I didn't hear you. Could you repeat that one?
