There is currently no requirement in the statutes that any of the lottery's advertising budget be used for problem gambling advertising. Again, this amendment, as Senator McDonald stated, is a compromise to which Senator McDonald agreed, and I would ask for your support. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Janssen. Open for discussion of the committee amendments. Open for discussion. Seeing no lights on, Senator Janssen, you're recognized to close. He waives closing. The question before the body is adoption of the committee amendments, AM2309. All in favor vote aye; opposed, nay. Voting on adoption of the committee amendments, General Affairs Committee. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of committee amendments.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The committee amendments have been adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Back to discussion of the bill itself. Senator McDonald, there are no lights on. Senator McDonald waives closing. The question before the body is, shall LB 1039 advance to E & R Initial? All in favor vote aye; opposed vote nay. Voting on the advancement of LB 1039. Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 34 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement of LB 1039.

SENATOR CUDABACK: LB 1039 does advance. (Visitors introduced.) We now go to LR 272CA, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: LR 272CA, by Senator Connealy, proposes an amendment to Article VIII, Section 12, of the Nebraska Constitution. The resolution was introduced on January 17, referred to the Urban Affairs Committee, advanced to the floor. There are Urban Affair Committee amendments, Mr. President.
