SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Chambers. You've heard the closing on the motion to bracket LB 75...LB 745 until April 11, '06. All in favor of the motion vote aye; opposed vote nay. Voting on the motion to bracket. Have you all voted on the motion to bracket who care to? Senator Chambers, for what purpose?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: I'll ask for a roll call vote.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Been a request for a roll call vote on the question. Mr. Clerk, when you get time, please call the roll.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal pages 1570-1571.) 19 ayes, 16 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to bracket.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Motion to bracket was not successful. I do raise the call. Mr. Clerk, please.

CLERK: Mr. President, Senator Chambers would move to reconsider the vote just taken.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Chambers, to open on your reconsideration motion.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Thank you. Mr. President, members of the Legislature, as I said, I may as well talk about this as any other bill. This proposal that we have before us today does not define terms in the bill. Some of the amendments that I have are designed to point out flaws in the bill, but I think before I get to some of those amendments I want to continue to discuss what we have before us. I'd like to ask Senator Janssen a question.
