chat occurs with all-day kindergarten students. A half-day kindergarten student is counted as one-half, a full day as one. So there would be an increase in the number of formula students; however, that change can occur with or without this bill, because over time, many school districts have simply expanded to all-day kindergarten on their own without any statutory requirement. So with that, I would ask your approval of the committee amendment. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Raikes. You've heard the closing on the committee amendments offered by the Education Committee, by Chairman Raikes.
