SPEAKER BRASHEAR: The committee amendments are adopted. We will now proceed to a vote on the advancement of LB 1024. All those in favor of the advancement signify by voting aye; those opposed vote nay. Senator Bourne, for what purpose do you rise?

SENATOR BOURNE: A roll call vote in regular order, please.

SPEAKER BRASHEAR: A roll call vote in regular order has been requested. Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: (Roll call vote taken, Legislative Journal page 1583.) 39 ayes, 9 nays, Mr. President, on the advancement.

SPEAKER BRASHEAR: Thank you, Mr. Clerk. LB 1024 is advanced. Mr. Clerk. The call is raised.

CLERK: Mr. President, with respect to LB 1024A, it's a bill offered by Senator Raikes. (Read title.)

SENATOR CUDABACK PRESIDING

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Raikes, to open.

SENATOR RAIKES: Thank you, Mr. President and members of the Legislature. The A bill provides some funding for a couple of things. Number one, as I mentioned, the Learning Community Coordinating Council would begin operations in September of 2006. There is a requirement for some money, \$36,000, to provide for expenses and a facilitator for that meeting. There's also money in this appropriations bill for establishing the high-needs coordinator in the Department of Education. Those are the two main items in the bill. I urge your adoption. Thank you.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: Mr. President, the first motion I have is by Senator Raikes. Senator, this is your motion to suspend the rules and permit the bill to move without further amendment, motion, or
