CLERK: 39 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the motion to return.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The motion was successful. The bill has been returned. Mr. Clerk, motion.

CLERK: Senator Friend offers AM3236. (Legislative Journal pages 1586-1587.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Friend, to open on AM3236.

SENATOR FRIEND: Thank you, Mr. President, members of the Legislature. Again, we're increasing penalties in two spots where we have no existing deterrent, as Senator Pedersen spoke of previously. Conversations with the Attorney General's Office, Senator Synowiecki, Senator Pedersen, and my office, I think we've got a bill here that provides deterrents, and in the long run will provide a safer environment for the drivers out there on the road. With that, I would ask for the adoption of AM3236. Thank you, Mr. President.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Thank you, Senator Friend. You've heard the opening on AM3236. Open for discussion. Senator Synowiecki.
