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FLOOR DEBATE

April 11, 2006      LB 454, 1227

CLERK:    Senator Flood, I have Enrollment and Review amendments, first of all. (AM7206, Legislative Journal page 1351.)

SENATOR CUDABACK:    Senator Flood, please.

SENATOR FLOOD:    Mr. President, I move the adoption of the E & R amendments to LB 1227.

SENATOR CUDABACK:    You've heard the motion to adopt the E & R amendments. All in favor say aye. Opposed, nay. They, too, are adopted.

CLERK:    Senator Mines, AM3079. I have a note you would like to withdraw.

SENATOR CUDABACK:    It is withdrawn.

CLERK:    Senator Mines, AM3150. (Legislative Journal page 1537.)

SENATOR CUDABACK:    Senator Mines, to open on AM3150 to LB 1227.

SENATOR MINES:    Thank you, Mr. President, colleagues. Let me tell you my intentions with this, right off the bat. This is an amendment that I proposed on...or, similar amendment that I proposed on LB 454. And I intend, after I speak on this, to withdraw it. So I don't...my intention is not to reopen the debate on LB 454. That's over. But I think it's...I have an interest, and I think we as a body have an interest, and I want to be on record as outlining for the body that LB 454 is imperfect legislation. I know it's through and it's signed; however, I want to point out just some things that I'll be back next year and ask your indulgence, ask half of your indulgence to look at an amendment or bill that might fix some of the unintended consequences. I don't believe any of these were purposefully admitted...omitted. But for your consideration, in LB 454, we can still carry handguns, concealed handguns, in federal, state, and local government buildings. We can still carry handguns in childcare centers. We can carry handguns, concealed, in domestic violence or sexual assault victim shelters, residences of other people without their permission,
