SENATOR CHAMBERS: But we don't...

SENATOR CONNEALY: (Laugh) Which one?

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Oh. How much time do I have, Mr. President? How much time do I have.

SENATOR CUDABACK: About nine seconds, Senator.

SENATOR CHAMBERS: Okay. Senator Landis, here is the question that I would like to you, and I will ask that you pay very close attention. In the event that you followed the discussion that was taking place,...
