Mines, you're recognized to close. There are no further lights on. You're recognized to close on AM3256.

SENATOR MINES: Thank you, Mr. President, colleagues, would urge your adoption of AM3256. Thank you for your patience and your understanding.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You've heard the closing on AM3256. All in favor of the amendment vote aye; all those opposed vote nay. Voting on adoption of the Mines amendment, AM3256 to LB 1113. Have you all voted on the motion who care to? Please record, Mr. Clerk.

CLERK: 31 ayes, 0 nays, Mr. President, on the adoption of Senators Mines' and Shrock's amendment.

SENATOR CUDABACK: The Mines-Schrock amendment has been adopted.

CLERK: I have nothing further on the bill.

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Flood.

SENATOR FLOOD: Mr. President, I move the advancement of LB 1113 to E & R for engrossing.

SENATOR CUDABACK: You've heard the motion to advance LB 1113 to E & R for engrossing. All in favor say aye. Opposed, nay. It is advanced. Mr. Clerk, LB 1113A.

CLERK: LB 1113A, no E & R, Senator Bourne would move to amend with AM3071. (Legislative Journal pages 1603-1604.)

SENATOR CUDABACK: Senator Bourne to open, AM3071.

SENATOR BOURNE: Thank you, Mr. President, members. Because of the Senator Aguilar amendment, there's a small fiscal note. The additional funds are composed of the following: \$22,500 for the Department of Health and Human Services for a one-time publication expense in providing written information in English and the foreign national minor's native language explaining the juvenile court process.
